

How can you help and why are you being contacted?





8:30 AM Pacific - Combing Cream Technologies: A New Growth Engine in the Hair Care Market

Trends in the Personal Care marketplace are continuously evolving, and the sources of these trends are equally dynamic. Historically, trends have been pushed out to consumers by finished goods companies. Furthermore, the trends had migrated in fairly predictable patterns, from developed countries into developing regions. However in recent times, we have seen the consumer gain a greater influence in driving trends and innovations, and these innovations can increasingly come from anywhere on the globe.

The rise of the "Combing Cream" in today's hair care marketplace is an excellent example of these changes in the marketplace. Combing creams evolved as a technology due to demand in the marketplace by consumers for such products. Combing Creams represent a large portion of the conditioner market in their birthplace - Brazil, and they are rapidly spreading into North America and the rest of the world.

In this session, we will discuss combing cream technologies, and their position in the hair care marketplace.
