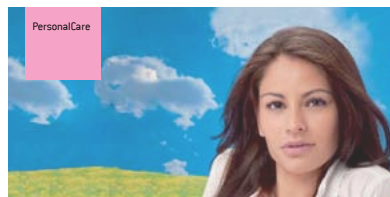

All presenters will be eligible for the Shaw Mudge Award sponsored by BASF Corporation, which is given for the Best Paper presented at Society's Annual Meeting. The honorarium for this award is \$2,500

Presenters are required to register for the Meeting.
