

He will show how techniques adapted from the field of human psychophysics are increasingly being used by those working with fragrance to support functional claims around olfactory stimulation: Everything from the use of fragrance



to make your clothes feel softer through making people look more attractive, and their skin younger looking. He also wants to look in the reverse direction and show how what we feel, see, and even what we hear can modulate what we perceive when we smell.




